As part of the UK's efforts to help build an effective global response to tackle undernutrition, the Department for International Development is supporting the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine to develop a distance-learning course on multi-sectoral nutrition programming.

It is being designed for practitioners working in health, humanitarian response, social development and agriculture and food security, to strengthen skills and capacity to design and evaluate programmes that effectively tackle undernutrition.
